VIII. RESOLUTION TO ADOPT THE BUDGET

NEPTUNE CITY BOARD OF EDUCATION RESOLUTION TO ADOPT BUDGET 2017-2018 April 27, 2017

WHEREAS, the Neptune City Board of Education recognizes school staff and Board members will incur travel expenses related to and within the scope of their current responsibilities and for travel that promotes the delivery of instruction or furthers the efficient operation of the school district; and

WHEREAS, N.J.A.C. 6A:23A-7.2 et seq. requires Board members to receive approval of these expenses by a majority of the full voting membership of the Board and staff members to receive prior approval of these expenses by the Superintendent of Schools and a majority of the full voting membership of the Board; and

WHEREAS, a Board of Education may establish, for regular district business travel as defined in NJAC 6A:23A-1.2, which includes attendance at regularly scheduled in-State county meetings, Department or

Association sponsored events or in-State professional development activities for which the registration fee does not exceed \$150.00 per employee or board member, where prior Board approval shall not be required unless the annual threshold for a staff member exceeds \$1,500 in a given school year (July 1 through June 30); and

WHEREAS, the Neptune City Board of Education established \$8,000 as the maximum travel amount for the current school year and has expended \$7,393.61 as of this date; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Board of Education approves travel and related expense reimbursements in accordance with N.J.A.C. 6A: 23A-7.3, to a maximum expenditure of \$11,500 for all staff and board members for the 2017-2018 school year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the automatic tax levy CAP adjustments for health benefits in the amounts of \$12,240. The additional funds are included in the base budget and will be used to pay for the additional increases in health benefits.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the budget be approved for the 2017-2018 School Year
