WHEREAS, none of our four sending school districts currently send at least 10% of Neptune Township High School enrollment;

WHEREAS, the four sending school districts currently collectively send 15% of Neptune Township High School enrollment which entitles the four sending school districts to two Board representatives;

WHEREAS, upon consultation of the Chief School Administrators (CSA's) only Bradley Beach and Neptune City will each appoint a Board Member to represent the sending school districts in Neptune Township;

BE IT RESOLVED, as recommended by the CSA's, Bradley Beach and Neptune City will eaach appoint a Board Member to represent the sending school districts in Neptune Township.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that at any time Belmar and Lake Como are interested in Board representation, the CSA's will reconvene to develop a rotation schedule to be reviewed and approved by their respective Boards.
