Through the adoption of this resolution, we, the Neptune City Board of Education, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 6:6A:23-2-11(c)4, certify that as of August 31, 2021 after review of the Secretary's monthly financial report (appropriations section) and upon consultation with the appropriate district officials, that to the best of our knowledge no major account or fund has been overexpended in violation of N.J.A.C. 6A:23-2.11(b) and that sufficient funds are available to meet the district's financial obligations for the remainder of the fiscal year.

- 7. To approve a tuition contract with the Manchester Township Board of Education for 1 full time students at their Regional Day School at the cost of \$72,000.00 for the 2021-2022 school year.

The project shall include replacement and upgrades to the existing HVAC in the school. This project shall include replacement of unit ventilators and rooftop compressors and associated controls. It shall also include the installation of a new plasma ionization device in each of the main supply ducts of the three (3) Roof Top Units (RTUs) complete with all required controls.

Five existing (5) ductless, mini split systems without fresh air shall be replaced with new HVAC with plasma ionization.

This is an Other Capital Project for which the Neptune City Board of Education will use ESSER II and ESSER III funding to complete.
